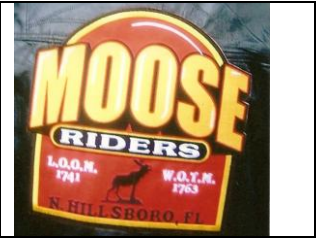

How to pay dues on-line:

Go to: <http://www.mooseintl.org>

Click on “**Pay Dues Online**” (top left of page)

Enter your Moose ID number And click “Pay Dues”.

If a coupon appears, then dues can be paid by credit card. You can print a receipt to carry with you until your new membership card arrives.

Please note: If you are a first time user, you will need to set up a user profile before you can pay your dues online.

How to mail in Chapter dues:

Paying dues at the lodge is still ok, but is not the preferred method because it slows the processing of payment to Moose International. When your cash or check to WOTM 1763 is received by the lodge, it waits for me to come in and prepare a Chapter check to Moose International, which then has to wait for the Sr. Regent or Secretary/Treasurer to come in and also sign the check. Then I can mail it to Moose International. Also, most dues payments I receive do not include the renewal notice coupon which also helps in speeding up the payment process. The sooner Moose Int'l receives the dues, the sooner you will receive your new membership card.

There will be a community service sign-in sheet on our WOTM bulletin board. Please keep track of your hours and mileage and list it on the sheet. Any community service work that you do with 2 or more coworkers is counted as Chapter community service. Be sure to sign in as WOTM Chapter 1763. The Chapter turns in the community service report monthly as this information is now required on our monthly Form 114's. Thank you for your help in keeping our community service reports accurate. If you do any community service individually, mark it as individual and our nominating committee will take that into consideration when we are nominating co-workers for International Co-worker of the Year. Thank you and hopefully this clears up the dues paying and community service questions.
